- A) ADOPTING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, INCLUDING CONFORMANCE WITH GENERAL PREVAILING WAGE SCALE REQUIREMENTS, FOR THE HALF MOON BAY AIRPORT RUNWAY PAVEMENT PRESERVATION PROJECT; AND**
- B) B) AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO CALL FOR SEALED PROPOSALS TO BE RECEIVED BY THURSDAY, APRIL 6, 2023 AT 2:30 P.M. IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE/CLERK OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS; AND**
- C) C) AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO EXTEND THE CALL FOR BIDS AND BID OPENING UP TO SIXTY (60) CALENDAR DAYS BEYOND THE TIME AND DATE ORIGINALLY SET FORTH BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS; AND**
- D) D) AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO EXECUTE GRANTS FROM THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION AND CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE HALF MOON BAY AIRPORT RUNWAY PAVEMENT PRESERVATION PROJECT**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works (Department) retained C&S Companies to provide design engineering services for the Half Moon Bay Airport Runway Pavement Preservation Project (Project) and prepare the plans and specifications for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Project has been designed in accordance with Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) guidelines and has been reviewed and approved by the FAA; and

WHEREAS, the Project plans and specifications dated March 10, 2023 have been prepared and approved by the Director of Public Works for the Project, and said plans and specifications have been filed in the office of the Director of Public Works (the “plans and specifications”); and

WHEREAS, the plans and specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing wages, as established by the Department of Industrial Relations and U.S. Department of Labor on federally funded projects, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of worker needed to execute the contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

1. The plans and specifications dated March 10, 2023, for the aforesaid Project, which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Works, and to which reference is hereby made for further particulars, are hereby approved and adopted as the plans and specifications to be adhered to in letting and performing the work under a contract for the improvements described therein.
2. Said specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing wages, as established by the Department of Industrial Relations and U.S. Department of Labor on federally funded projects, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of worker needed to execute the contract.

3. The Department of Public Works is authorized and directed to issue a call for sealed bids and to set the bid opening date and time on Thursday, April 6, 2023 at 2:30 p.m. in the office of the County Executive/Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in the Hall of Justice, Redwood City, California. Said bids will be received by the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and then transmitted to the County Executive's Office in said Hall of Justice and be publicly opened and declared.
4. The Director of Public Works is authorized to extend the call for bids and bid opening up to sixty (60) calendar days beyond the time and date originally set forth by the Board of Supervisors.
5. The Department of Public Works is further directed to cause the Notice inviting sealed bids to be published for three (3) times in a weekly local newspaper of general circulation, published in the County, and obtain an affidavit of said publication, a copy of which shall be placed on file with the Department of Public Works.
6. The Director of Public Works is authorized to execute grants from the Federal Aviation Administration and California Department of Transportation for the Half Moon Bay Airport Runway Pavement Preservation Project.

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
