Overview of Ordinance

- Restricts County's ability to cooperate with or assist Immigration Authorities in immigration enforcement activities
- Includes limited exceptions

 Absent an exception applying, County <u>entities</u> and <u>personnel</u> cannot use County <u>resources</u> to:

- Absent an exception applying, County <u>entities</u> and <u>personnel</u> cannot use County <u>resources</u> to:
 - 1. Assist or cooperate with Immigration Authorities to hold, detain, house, transfer, or facilitate arrest of individuals in County custody

 Absent an exception applying, County <u>entities</u> and <u>personnel</u> cannot use County <u>resources</u> to:

2. Communicate with Immigration Authorities to assist or cooperate in immigration enforcement, including information gathering

 Absent an exception applying, County <u>entities</u> and <u>personnel</u> cannot use County <u>resources</u> to:

3. Provide access to or use of non-public County property to Immigration Authorities



General Exceptions (subd. (a))

- Restrictions do not apply (i.e., County resources can be used) if:
 - Assistance is pursuant to a judicial warrant
 - Requires probable cause for a violation of federal criminal immigration law
 - Issued by a federal judge
 - Assistance is required by federal or state law
 - "Fail-safe" exception

Specific Exception (subd. (b))

- Restrictions do not apply (i.e., County resources can be used) if:
 - Assisting in criminal investigations and enforcement that do not involve "immigration enforcement" under the California Values Act
 - No assisting in civil investigations or enforcement
 - No assisting in investigations or enforcement of federal criminal immigration laws that penalize someone's presence in, entry, or reentry to, or employment in, the United States
