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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT 2 TO THE GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE SAN MATEO AREA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, REDEFINING THE PAYMENT TERMS, AMENDING THE TERM OF THE AGREEMENT FROM JUNE 14, 2022 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2024 TO A NEW TERM OF JUNE 14, 2022 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2023 AND ADDING TO THE SCOPE OF SERVICES, WITH NO CHANGE TO THE NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT, AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE AMENDMENT

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, on June 14, 2022, this Board approved a one-time grant of district-discretionary Measure K funds in an amount not to exceed \$115,000 to the San Mateo Area Chamber of Commerce to support the Chamber's Business Assessment Center (supporting a part-time employee and the purchase of new technology for the Center) for the term June 14, 2022 through November 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, on December 13, 2022, this Board approved Amendment 1 to the Agreement, extending the term through June 30, 2024, providing an exception to the criteria for district-discretionary Measure K funds to allow for advanced payment of half of the grant, replacing Exhibits A and B in their entireties, with no change to the not-to-exceed amount of the agreement; and

WHEREAS, it is the Board's intent for the County Executive, or designee, to execute a further amendment to the Grant Agreement ("Amendment 2") to redefine the payment terms of the grant, amend the term of the agreement, and replace Exhibit A

(rev. December 13, 2022) and Exhibit B (rev. December 13, 2022) in their entireties, as noted in the Board transmittal attached to this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Amendment 2 is consistent with the criteria for district-discretionary

Measure K funds approved by the Board in December 2018; and

WHEREAS, there is no fiscal impact to the County as the not-to-exceed amount is unchanged; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of Amendment 2 to the grant agreement and has examined it and approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter into Amendment 2 to the grant agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors approves said Amendment 2 to the grant agreement, and authorizes the County Executive, or designee to execute Amendment 2 to the grant agreement.

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
