A future development proposal on the property would not automatically trigger the need for a public hearing. Rather, the specific scope of a development proposal will determine if a public hearing is needed. If the proposal is consistent with the new zoning and all other applicable adopted land use regulations, then the development may only require a ministerial building permit to move forward.
