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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH FRESH LIFELINES FOR YOUTH, INC. SECURED THROUGH JUVENILE JUSTICE REALIGNMENT BLOCK GRANT (JJRBG) FUNDING TO PROVIDE LAW-RELATED EDUCATION AND CAREER NAVIGATION WORKSHOPS AND CASE MANAGEMENT AND COACHING FOR YOUTH AT THE YOUTH SERVICES CENTER-JUVENILE HALL FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2023, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2026, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$229,369.04

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, in November 2022, the Probation Department released a request for proposals (RFP) for programs and services to be funded through the county's annual Juvenile Justice Realignment Block Grant (JJRBG) allocation; and

WHEREAS, Fresh Lifelines for Youth, Inc. was selected through this RFP to provide services to youth in the Success and Opportunities Aspiring Readiness for Reentry (SOARR) Program at the Youth Services Center-Juvenile Hall; and

WHEREAS, the Probation Department and Fresh Lifelines for Youth, Inc. wish to enter into an Agreement to provide law-related education and career navigation workshops and case management and coaching for a term of July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2026, in an amount not to exceed \$229,369.04; and

WHEREAS, through this Agreement, Fresh Lifelines for Youth, Inc. will lead a design process that to build out new, innovative services for SOARR youth who face

longer commitments and unique needs, with the goal of preparing these youth for reentry, achieving goals while in custody, and supporting them as they transition back to the community; and

WHEREAS, the Board has been presented with this Agreement and has approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter into the Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of the Board is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Agreements for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Probation Officer or his designee is authorized to execute contract amendments that modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate) for said Agreement, and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as he modified term of services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
