## SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO AND SAMARITAN HOUSE

called "County," and Samaritan House, hereinafter called "Contractor";	

## $\underline{W} \underline{I} \underline{T} \underline{N} \underline{E} \underline{S} \underline{S} \underline{E} \underline{T} \underline{H}$ :

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 31000, County may contract with independent contractors for the furnishing of such services to or for County or any Department thereof;

WHEREAS, on June 29, 2021, the parties entered into an Agreement for the purpose of providing Coordinated Entry System and Diversion Services to prevent individuals from exiting institutions into homelessness for the term of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024, for a total amount not to exceed \$2,721,457; and

WHEREAS, on June 16, 2022, the parties amended the Agreement to provide Diversion and CES services to individuals exiting facilities in San Mateo County with the term remaining July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2024, and the total amount remains \$2,721,457; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the Agreement to add \$93,392 in funds in order to provide a cost-of-living adjustment.

## NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 3. Payments of the Agreement is amended to read as follows:

In consideration of the services provided by Contractor in accordance with all terms, conditions, and specifications set forth in this Agreement and in Exhibit A, County shall make payment to Contractor based on the rates and in the manner specified in Exhibit B. County reserves the right to withhold payment if County determines that the quantity or quality of the work performed is unacceptable. In no event shall County's total fiscal obligation under this Agreement exceed **TWO MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED**FOURTEEN THOUSAND, EIGHT HUNDRED AND FORTY-NINE DOLLARS (\$2,814,849). In the event that County makes any advance payments, Contractor agrees to refund any amounts in excess of the amount owed by County at the time of contract termination or expiration. Contractor is not entitled to payment for work not performed as required by this Agreement.
