RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING: A) THE ACCEPTANCE OF CASH DONATIONS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$231,564 FROM THE SAN MATEO COUNTY PARKS FOUNDATION AND \$15,500 FROM THE MOUNTED PATROL OF SAN MATEO COUNTY FOR FY 2022-23; AND B) THE ACCEPTANCE OF IN-KIND DONATIONS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$143,700 FROM THE FRIENDS OF HUDDART AND WUNDERLICH PARKS THROUGH A DONATION FROM BETH GUILLAUMIN PERRELL FOR FY 2022-23

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, this Board of Supervisors highly values and appreciates financial contributions to the San Mateo County Parks Department (the “Parks Department”); and

WHEREAS, the San Mateo County Parks Foundation (“Parks Foundation”) is providing \$231,564 in cash donations to the Parks Department for the 2022-23 Fiscal Year to help fund projects, programs, and events at various County parks; and

WHEREAS, the \$231,564 in cash donations from the Parks Foundation will be deposited in the Parks Department’s Gifts and Donations revenue account and used as follows: \$80,000 for the Parks Department’s Memorial Bench Program; \$50,000 for the Coyote Point Recreation Area Tree Health Program; \$40,000 for a Friendship Park and Flood County Park intern; \$18,000 for a Memorial Park Crumb Clean naturalist summer intern; \$15,000 for the Bicycle Sunday Program; \$11,128 for ADA picnic sites at Memorial Park; \$10,000 for Oxalis Treatment at San Bruno Mountain State and County

Park; \$6,410 for the Edgewood Park and Natural Preserve Farms Project; and \$1,026 for vehicle entrance passes for events; and

WHEREAS, the Parks Department received a cash donation of \$15,500 from the Mounted Patrol of San Mateo County, who has partnered with the Parks Department to complete a trail clearing project in Pescadero Creek County Park for the removal of storm damaged trees, brush trimming, treading, and the removal of invasive species; and

WHEREAS, the Friends of Huddart and Wunderlich Parks, through a donation received by Beth Guillaumin Perrell, provided in in-kind donation to the Parks Department in the amount of \$143,700 to make improvements to the hay barn and horse corrals at Wunderlich County Park; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors by adoption of this Resolution hereby authorizes:

1. The acceptance of cash donations in the amount of \$231,564 from the San Mateo County Parks Foundation and \$15,500 from the Mounted Patrol of San Mateo County for FY 2022-23.
2. The acceptance of in-kind donations in the amount of \$143,700 from the Friends of Huddart and Wunderlich Parks for FY 2022-23.
