

#### Significant Budget Changes



- Increased costs in Pathology department due to a new Pathology facility and new equipment service warranties
- Purchase of additional equipment and supplies for new morgue
- Increased investigation costs due to inflation

➤ Case closures within 90 days — IAC&ME accreditation standards and allow families to handle affairs following the death of a loved one sooner
