





Assessment Roll Growth


Net Combined Roll Value (Est.) 2010-2023*







November 8, 2022, Statewide General Election



How to Register:

Go to RegisterToVote.ca.gov or pick up a voter registration form from any library, post office or city hall. If you register by October 24, a ballot will be mailed to you. From October 25 to November 8, go to a Vote Center to register and vote on the same day.

Every city in the county will have at least one Vote Center open daily from November 5 to November 8.



What's Your Voter Registration Home?

You can use cross streets, the street where you sleep most nights, and include the street name of the corner closest to you.

Why do I need a "home" address?

Your voter registration home address allows us to send you the appropriate ballot for your voting precinct.

Please also provide a mailing address. You will be mailed a ballot if you register by October 24 and 29 days before each future election.

If you do not have a mailing address, you can use "General Delivery" to the Main Post Office in any city. Mail will be held for up to 30 days before it is returned to our office.

You can also vote in person at a Vote Center. To find a location, go to smcvote.org.



Will I need to show a Driver's license to vote?

You need to show identification of some type the first time you vote if you do not include a California Driver's License (or State ID) number or the last four digits of your Social Security number on your registration form.




