WHEREAS, this Board has previously adopted Resolution No. 72299,

(BHC) standing rules for its governance; and

that each local mental health board shall develop bylaws to be approved by the governing body, which in the case of BHC, is defined as the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the BHC desires to amend its bylaws to reflect the addition of a Veteran and/or Veteran Advocate seat to the BHC Membership as mandated by the 2022 State Legislative Assembly Bill 738, WIC § 5604(a)(2)(C); and

WHEREAS, the San Mateo County BHC has adopted the amended bylaws and this Board of Supervisors has been presented with a form of the amended bylaws and has examined it as to both form and content and desires to approve them.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the

amended bylaws approved by the San Mateo County BHC is hereby approved.
