## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH SLOAN SAKAI YEUNG AND WONG LLC TO PROVIDE LABOR NEGOTIATION AND CONSULTATION SERVICES FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$450,000 FOR THE TERM OF SEPTEMBER 12, 2023 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 1, 2026

**RESOLVED,** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, on May 18, 2023, the Human Resources Department publicly posted a Request for Proposal (RFP) undertaking a competitive solicitation to identify an agency to provide labor negotiation and consultation services; and

WHEREAS, on June 7, 2023, the RFP closed, with four proposals having been received, and following an evaluation process that took into account input from multiple County departments and subject matter experts, Sloan Sakai Yeung and Wong LLC was selected; and

WHEREAS, the Human Resources Department is proposing that the County enter an agreement with Sloan Sakai Yeung and Wong LLC to provide labor negotiation and consultation services for an amount not to exceed \$450,000, for a term of September 12, 2023, through September 1, 2026; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with the agreement and wishes to approve same as to both form and content and desires to enter into the agreement; and

## NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the

President of the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement with Sloan Sakai Yeung and Wong LLC to provide labor negotiation and consultation services for an amount not to exceed \$450,000; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Human Resources Director, or the Director's designee, is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.
