WHEREAS, the **Montara Water and Sanitary District** has a rich history starting in 1907 with the beginnings of the Oceanshore Railroad and the sale of homes on the San Mateo Coast; and

WHEREAS, the **Montara Water and Sanitary District** provides and excels in maintaining public health and well-being by maintaining over 20 miles of water pipes and contracting with Recology of the Coast in the weekly collection of waste from the residents of the district: and

WHEREAS, the **Montara Water and Sanitary District** is second to none in the stewardship of the environment for the residents of the district, including Recology’s active recycle program that helps maintain the coastal environment so residents thrive; and

WHEREAS, when the residents voted with an 82% majority in 2001 to approve a bond for the purchase of the private water company, the residents ensured the long-term quality, quantity, access to and safety of water for generations to come; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo celebrates and recognizes the 65<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the **Montara Water and Sanitary District** and celebrates the accomplishments of its staff, residents, and ratepayers for ensuring future generation of water quality,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, hereby commends the **Montara Water and Sanitary District** on its 65<sup>th</sup> anniversary and, on behalf of all residents, expresses sincere congratulations and appreciation for its achievements and contributions to the people of San Mateo County.
