- Two way communication between the community and the Sheriff


- Support Sheriff's deputies in their mission to protect and serve

TWICE AS LIKELY


as White people to be arrested

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What Community Voice Looks Like

Civilian Oversight Board

(community members)



Inspector General (IG)

(Attorney)

Both Board and IG:

- Are appointed by BoS
- Have subpoena power
- Review and recommend policies
- Make public reports
- Dialogue with Sheriff

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Oversight Board

Composition: 11 community members

- impartial
- knowledgeable
- committed
- diverse in location and life experience

Responsibilities:

- Monthly public meetings
- Community outreach
- Receive complaints and concerns
- Issue public reports

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Inspector General

- Attorney with criminal law experience
- Investigate complaints from residents
- Investigate incidents and trends including:
 - excessive force
 - deaths in custody
 - racial profiling trends



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Necessary for Effectiveness

Independence

from the Sheriff's Office

Support

from Board of Supervisors

Access

to records, including by subpoena when needed

Ability to hear

complaints directly from residents

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Representation

from the entire community

Funding

to do its work



Oversight - necessary but limited

Oversight DOES

Create transparency and accountability through public reports to the Board of Supervisors, the Sheriff, and the public

Oversight DOES NOT

- Set policy for the Sheriff or Board of Supervisors
- Discipline or fire deputies



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State law AB1185 gives subpoena power to oversight boards & inspectors general but does not create these boards/offices



Benefits to the Sheriff's Office

- Can advocate for resources the Office needs for reform
 - Unarmed mental health response
 - Alternatives to jail for mental health
 - Community engagement
- Independent intermediary to build trust
- Promotes dialogue instead of adversarial / lawsuit response to issues
- Does not take away the power and position of the Sheriff or Sheriff's Office
