BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH SAMARITAN HOUSE TO PROVIDE EMERGENCY FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AND HOMELESSNESS PREVENTION SERVICES FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2024 TO JUNE 30, 2027, WITH A TOTAL OBLIGATION AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$10,500,000

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Emergency Financial Assistance and Homelessness Prevention Program provides crisis support and short-term financial assistance to San Mateo County residents to help those experiencing homelessness return to housing, and those at imminent risk of becoming homeless stay housed; and

WHEREAS, in November 2023, the County of San Mateo's Human Services Agency (HSA) conducted a Request for Proposals to identify a provider for homelessness prevention and financial assistance services and Samaritan House was selected because of its experience, qualifications and approach to best meet the needs of the County; and

WHEREAS, this agreement with Samaritan House will allow the County to provide homelessness prevention services such as one-time rental assistance, payment of utility arrears, and crisis support services to program participants to help remove immediate barriers to housing stability; and

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Board of Supervisors for its consideration and acceptance an agreement, reference to which is hereby made for further particulars, whereby Samaritan House will provide emergency financial assistance and homelessness prevention services to eligible program participants for the term of July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2027, for a total obligation amount not to exceed \$10,500,000; and

WHEREAS, this Board has approved the agreement as to both form and content and desires to enter into the agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of the Board be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Human Services Agency or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in the aggregate), and/or modify the contract and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
