IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY MANAGER/CLERK OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS; AND C) AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO EXTEND THE CALL FOR BIDS AND BID OPENING UP TO SIXTY (60) CALENDAR DAYS BEYOND THE TIME AND DATE ORIGINALLY SET FORTH BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of

California, that

WHEREAS, dredging specific channel locations within the Coyote Point Marina has

been identified as a high priority project for the San Mateo County Department of Parks; and

WHEREAS, plans and specifications dated April 21, 2017 have been prepared

and approved by the Director of Public Works for the Coyote Point Marina 2017

Maintenance Dredging Project, which includes dredging portions of the main entry and

secondary channels within the Coyote Point Marina; and said plans and specifications have

been filed in the office of the Director of Public Works (the "plans and specifications")

and

WHEREAS, the plans and specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing wages, as established by the Department of Industrial Relations, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of workman needed to execute the contract..

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

- 1. The plans and specifications dated April 21, 2017, for the aforesaid project, which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Works, and to which reference is hereby made for further particulars, are hereby approved and adopted as the plans and specifications to be adhered to in letting and performing the work under a contract for the improvements described therein.
- 2. Said specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing wages, as established by the Department of Industrial Relations, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of workman needed to execute the contract.
- 3. The Department of Public Works is authorized and directed to issue a call for sealed bids and to set the bid opening date and time on Wednesday, June 7, 2017 at 2:30 p.m. in the office of the County Manager/Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in the Hall of Justice, Redwood City, California. Said bids will be received by the Deputy Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and then transmitted to the County Manager's Office in said Hall of Justice and be publicly opened and declared.
- 4. The Director of Public Works is authorized to extend the call for bids and bid opening up to sixty (60) calendar days beyond the time and date originally set forth by the Board of Supervisors.

5. The Department of Public Works is further directed to cause the Notice inviting sealed bids to be published for two (2) times in a weekly local newspaper of general circulation, published in the County, and to obtain an affidavit of said publication, a copy of which shall be placed on file with the Department of Public Works.
