RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH THE MULTICULTURAL INSTITUTE TO PROVIDE OUTREACH EMPLOYMENT MATCHING SERVICES, EXTENDING THE TERM BY ONE YEAR, FOR A NEW TERM OF JULY 1, 2015 TO JUNE 30, 2018, AND INCREASING THE AMOUNT BY \$165,324 TO AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$483,177

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, on July 7, 2015, the Board of Supervisors approved an agreement with The Multicultural Institute to provide street-based community outreach services to day laborers and employers in the Fair Oaks Community in Redwood City; and

WHEREAS, these outreach services ensure the safety of the public, address the economic concerns of the community, and increase self-sufficiency in the community by linking day laborers with employers and existing training programs and linking day laborers to legal, medical, and educational social services; and

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Board of Supervisors for its consideration and acceptance an amendment to the agreement, reference to which is hereby made for further particulars, extending the term by one year from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2018 and increasing the amount by \$165,324 for a new amount not to exceed \$483,177; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Amendment to the Agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Human Services Agency or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.
