RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HIRING OF RETIRED DEPARTMENTAL SYSTEM ANALYST, GREGORY RANDICH, IN ORDER TO PROVIDE ASSISTANCE IN MANAGING THE 2016 UNSECURED PROPERTY ROLL CLOSE AND PROVIDE TRAINING TO A NEWLY TRAINED SUCCESSOR, PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 7522(F)(1), AND FINDING THAT THE NATURE OF EMPLOYMENT AND APPOINTMENT IS NECESSARY TO FILL A CRITICALLY-NEEDED POSITION DURING THE 180-DAY POST-RETIREMENT SEPARATION PERIOD

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Assessor's Office is responsible for determining the assessed value of all taxable property located in San Mateo County and Closing the 2016 Roll by June 30, 2017; and

WHEREAS, retired Departmental System Analyst Gregory Randich has unique skills, expertise, and knowledge in the managing and supporting the unsecured property information utilized to process the San Mateo County Roll Close; and

WHEREAS, the knowledge and expertise Gregory Randich is able to provide to his newly trained successor is essential and unattainable from current County personnel; and

WHEREAS, Government Code §7522.56 requires a One-Hundred Eighty (180) day separation period, as established by the California Public Employees' Pension

Reform Act, unless the employer's governing body makes a finding by certifying that the appointment is necessary to fill a critically needed position before the One-Hundred Eighty (180) day separation period has passed; and

WHEREAS, Gregory Randich's' services are needed prior to the expiration of the One-Hundred-Eighty (180) day separation period.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the hiring of retired Departmental Systems

Analyst Gregory Randich to extra help position in order to provide assistance on the 2016 Roll Close pursuant to Government Code §7522.56(f)(1), and finds that the nature of employment and appointment is necessary to fill a critically-needed position before Mr. Randich's post-retirement 180 day separation period expires.
