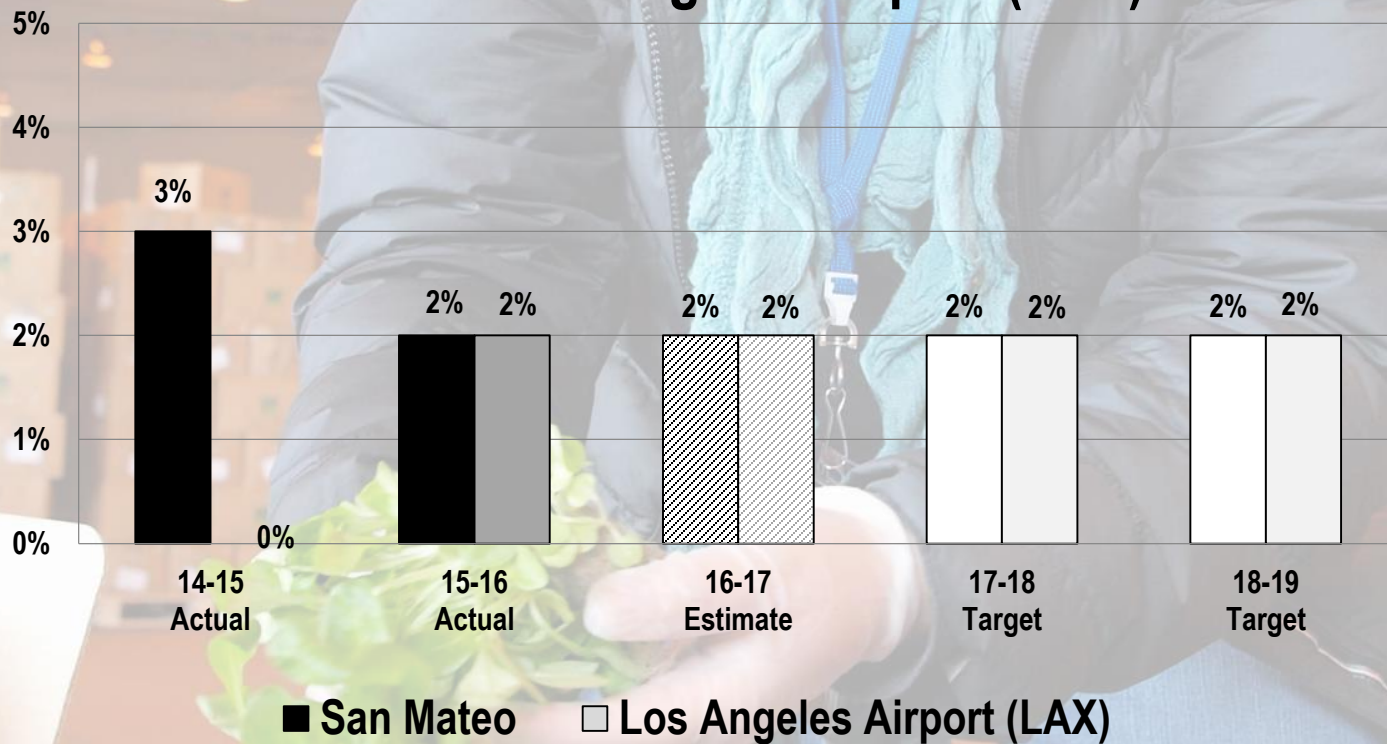

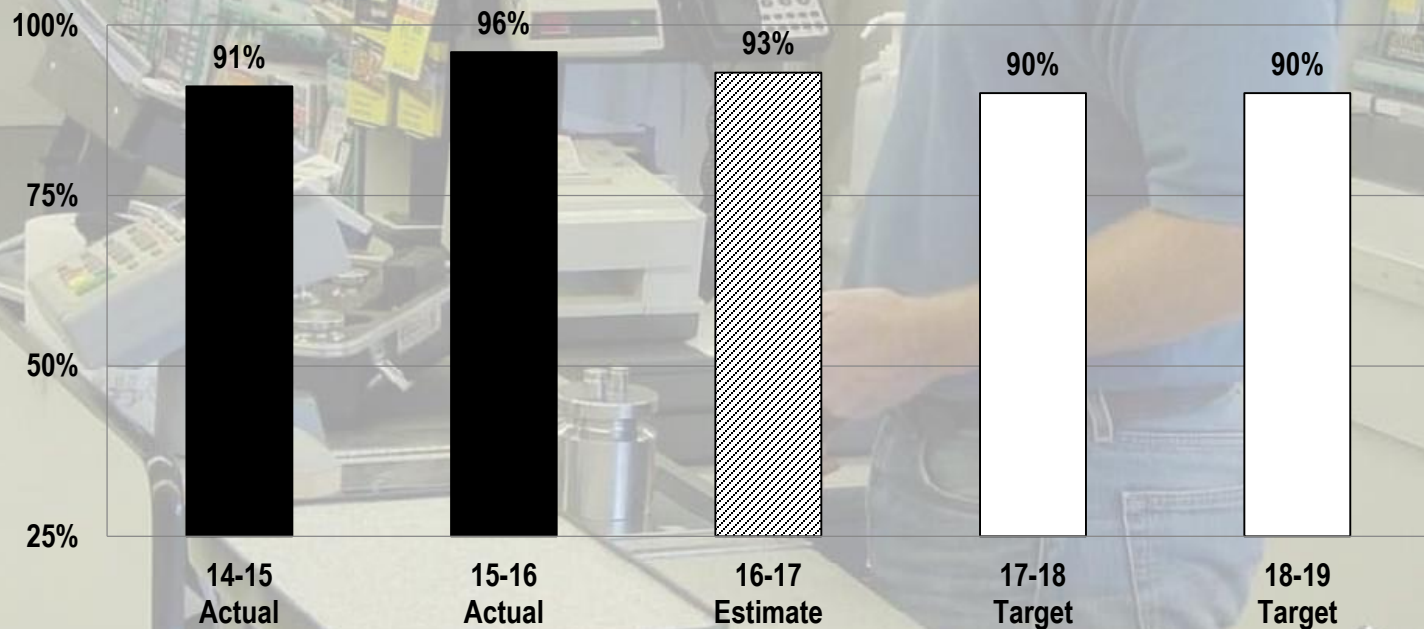
## Headline Measure #1
