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MEASURE K: RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH THE REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA TO SUPPORT UC COOPERATIVE EXTENSION HEAD, HEART, HEALTH, HAND (4H) YOUTH DEVELOPMENT THROUGH THE HEALTHY LIVING AMBASSADORS PROGRAM, EXTENDING THE TERM THROUGH JUNE 30, 2019, AND INCREASING THE AMOUNT BY \$61,800 TO AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$121,800

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2015, the Director of Public Health, Policy and Planning approved an agreement with the Regents of the University of California to support UC Cooperative Extension through the Healthy Living Ambassadors program; and

WHEREAS, the contract with Regents of the University of California will allow UC Cooperative Extension to enroll 50 teens in the Healthy Living Ambassadors program and to enroll at least 350 children ages 7-10 in the educational curricula over a 6-10 week period; and

WHEREAS, the curricula may include garden-based nutrition education or the Coordinated Approach To Child Health physical activity curriculum; and

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an agreement on July 1, 2015, with Regents of the University of California, in an amount not to exceed \$60,000; and

WHEREAS, the parties now wish to amend the agreement to increase the amount by \$61,800 to an amount not to exceed \$121,800 and extend the term to June 30, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Board has been presented with the amendment and has examined and approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter into the amendment.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said amendment for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief of the Health System or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
