BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

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ADOPT A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS THROUGH THE JUVENILE JUSTICE CRIME PREVENTION ACT (JJCPA): A) AN AGREEMENT WITH ACKNOWLEDGE ALLIANCE TO PROVIDE CONTINUOUS CRITICAL INTERVENTIONS TO AT-RISK YOUTH THROUGH ON-SITE INDIVIDUAL AND GROUP PSYCHODYNAMIC COUNSELLING AND TRANSITION PROGRAMS AT THE SAN MATEO COUNTY COMMUNITY AND COURT SCHOOLS FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2017, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2020, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$151,230; AND B) AN AGREEMENT WITH FRESH LIFELINES FOR YOUTH, INC. TO PROVIDE CONTINUOUS LAW AND LEADERSHIP PROGRAM FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2017, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2020, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$130,586; AND C) AN AGREEMENT WITH STARVISTA TO PROVIDE CONTINUOUS HOLISTIC SYSTEM OF CARE TO SUPPORT AT-RISK YOUTH WITH MENTAL HEALTH ISSUES AND AS WELL AS VICTIM IMPACT AWARENESS TO ADOLESCENTS FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2017, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2020, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$568,752

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, in January 2017, the Probation Department issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) to establish contracts for Youth and Family Programs identified in the 2016 Local Action Plan (LAP) and funded through the Juvenile Justice Crime Prevention Act (JJCPA) and the Juvenile Probation and Camps Funding (JPCF); and

WHEREAS, Acknowledge Alliance, Fresh Lifelines for Youth, Inc. and StarVista have been selected through the RFP process to provide services to at-risk youth.

WHEREAS, the Probation Department and Acknowledge Alliance wish to enter into an Agreement to provide critical interventions to at-risk youth through on-site individual and group psychodynamic counseling and transition programs at the San

Mateo County Community and Court Schools for a term of July 1, 2017, through June 30, 2020, in an amount not to exceed \$151,230.00; and

WHEREAS, the Probation Department and Fresh Lifeline for Youth, Inc. wish to enter into an Agreement to provide a Law and Leadership Program for a term of July 1, 2017, through June 30, 2020, in an amount not to exceed \$130,586.00 and

WHEREAS, the Probation Department and StarVista wish to enter into an Agreement to provide a holistic system of care of youth-centered services through the Seeking Safety Program and family-centered programming through the Family Skills Training and Victim Impact Awareness for adolescents for the term of July 1, 2017, through June 30, 2020, in an amount not to exceed \$568,752.00; and

WHEREAS, the Board has been presented with this Agreement and has approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter into the Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of the Board is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Probation Officer or his designee is authorized to execute contract amendments that modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as he modified term of services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
