RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH SAN MATEO COUNTY
OFFICE OF EDUCATION TO PROVIDE AND MAINTAIN ACADEMIC CENTERS FOR
THE TERM OF SEPTEMBER 12, 2017 THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2020 IN AN
AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$900,000

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, Academic Centers play an essential role in the community by providing a safe venue for students who are at risk of disengaging from school by increasing their academic proficiency through individualized academic support; and

WHEREAS, Academic Centers provide before and after school academic support for approximately 1,309 students attending 33 schools in 14 school districts in the 2015-16 academic school year; and

WHEREAS, San Mateo County Office of Education administers the Academic Centers program by coordinating program requirements, reporting, and funding with school districts to customize Academic Centers to meet the needs of student populations, including English Language Learners; and

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Board of Supervisors for its consideration and acceptance an agreement, reference to which is hereby made for further particulars, whereby San Mateo County Office of Education shall provide and

maintain Academic Centers for the term of September 12, 2017 through August 31, 2020 in an amount not to exceed \$900,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Human Services Agency or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.
