## PATRICK SWEETLAND

**WHEREAS**, after a successful tenure working for Assemblyman Lou Papan, **MR. PATRICK SWEETLAND** started his employment with the City of Daly City on March 8, 1987, as a Administrative Assistant III in the Department of Public works, heralding the beginning of what would become a 30-year career; and,

WHEREAS, MR. PATRICK SWEETLAND spent most of his first six years in the Department of Public Works, including stints as the Electrical/Building Inspector Supervisor, and Storm Water Program Supervisor, before joining the City Manager's Office as Senior Management Analyst on July 1, 1994, where he oversaw Daly City's Transportation System Management Program, the Solid Waste Diversion program, the BFI Franchise Agreement, and served as the General Program Coordinator of the San Mateo County-wide National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System(NPDES) Storm Water Management Program; and,

**WHEREAS**, on December 11, 1995, just 16 months after settling into his role in the City Manager's Office, **MR. PATRICK SWEETLAND** was appointed Acting Director of the Department of Water/Wastewater Resources, and on June 10, 1996, Patrick became the Director of the Department, a position he would hold for more than 21 years; and,

WHEREAS, among MR. PATRICK SWEETLAND'S greatest achievements was the successful completion of the North San Mateo County Sanitation District's first Tertiary Water Treatment System and provides recycled water for irrigation at nearby golf courses and Daly City parks and landscaped medians, making a Conjunctive Use Agreement for Groundwater Storage and Recovery a reality by 2014, a landmark agreement between the City of Daly City, San Francisco Public Utilities Commission, City of San Bruno, and Cal Water; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the members of the San Mateo County Board of Supervisors do hereby commend **MR. PATRICK SWEETLAND**, Master of Acronyms and Purveyor of Fun, for his more than 30 years of service to the City of Daly City.
