- **SUBJECT:** Amendment No. 2 to the Agreement with the Department of Veterans Affairs Palo Alto Health Care System

# **RECOMMENDATION:**

Adopt a Resolution authorizing the:

- A) President of the Board to execute Amendment No. 2 to the Agreement with the Department of Veterans Affairs Palo Alto Health Care System for the provision of space and resources for Willow Clinic, extending the term by thirteen months from August 11, 2006 through March 31, 2013, and increasing the maximum amount payable by \$525,560.36 to an amount not to exceed \$4,442,512.68; and
- B) Chief of the Health System or designee to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

# **BACKGROUND:**

In March 1997, your Board approved a Sharing Agreement with the Department of Veterans Affairs Palo Alto Health Care System (VAPAHCS) for space in Building 334 on the VAPAHCS Menlo Park campus to locate and operate the Willow Clinic. Your Board approved subsequent Amendments and Supplemental Agreements to secure additional space for services such as the Methadone Treatment Program. In October 2006, your Board approved a five-year Agreement for the term August 11, 2006 through August 10, 2011, for continued County operations at the VAPAHCS Willow Campus. The clinic has been operational since that time. On November 15, 2011, your Board approved Resolution 071724 to increase the maximum amount and extend the term, while negotiations for a new lease could be finalized.

## **DISCUSSION:**

The County is developing a consolidated South County Clinic at the Fair Oaks Clinic

site in unincorporated Redwood City. It is anticipated that consolidation of the Willow Clinic at that site will be accomplished in July 2013. VAPAHCS has agreed to amend the Agreement, extending the term by thirteen months at the VA campus. This Amendment permits the Willow Clinic to continue operating through March 31, 2013. The Veterans Administration has indicated they will negotiate a further Amendment for the period of April 1, 2013 through July 31, 2013.

County Counsel has reviewed and approved this Amendment and Resolution as to form.

The Contractor has assured compliance with the County's Contractor Employee Jury Service Ordinance, as well as all other contract provisions that are required by County ordinance and administrative memoranda, including but not limited to insurance, hold harmless, non-discrimination and equal benefits.

This Agreement contributes to the Shared Vision 2025 outcome of a Healthy Community by continuing to provide health services for patients at the Willow Clinic. It is anticipated that patient satisfaction results will increase from 81% to 83%.

## FISCAL IMPACT:

The Amendment extends the term of the Agreement by thirteen months from August 11, 2006 through March 31, 2013, and increases the maximum amount payable under the Agreement by \$525,560.36 to a maximum obligation of \$4,442,512.68. Funds in the amount of \$178,564.00 are included in the San Mateo Medical Center's FY 2011-12 Adopted Budget, and funds in the amount of \$346,996.68 will be included in the SMMC FY 2012-13 Recommended Budget.

Expenses at SMMC are covered by fees for services or third-party payors whenever possible. The portion of expenses for services provided to the medically indigent or to those covered by programs that do not meet the full costs of care are covered by the County's General Fund contribution to SMMC.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE: A) PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD TO EXECUTE AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO THE AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS PALO ALTO HEALTH CARE SYSTEM FOR THE PROVISION OF SPACE AND RESOURCES FOR WILLOW CLINIC, EXTENDING THE TERM BY THIRTEEN MONTHS FROM AUGUST 11, 2006 THROUGH MARCH 31, 2013, AND INCREASING THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT PAYABLE BY \$525,560.36 TO AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$4,442,512.68; AND B) CHIEF OF THE HEALTH SYSTEM OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE CONTRACT AMENDMENTS WHICH MODIFY THE COUNTY'S MAXIMUM FISCAL OBLIGATION BY NO MORE THAN \$25,000 (IN AGGREGATE), AND/OR MODIFY THE CONTRACT TERM AND/OR SERVICES SO LONG AS THE MODIFIED TERM OR SERVICES IS/ARE WITHIN THE CURRENT OR REVISED FISCAL PROVISIONS.

**RESOLVED,** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, a Sharing Agreement between the County and the United States

Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) allowing the County to use space and services at

the VA's Palo Alto Health Care System (VAPAHCS) campus for the County's Willow

Clinic and related programs expires on February 10, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the County is developing a consolidated South County Clinic at the

Fair Oaks Clinic site in unincorporated Redwood City with an anticipated completion date of July 2013, and VAPAHCS has agreed to amend the Agreement, extending the term by thirteen months at the VA campus for the provision of space and resources at the Willow Clinic until March 31, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Veteran's Administration has indicated they will negotiate a

further Amendment for the period of April 1, 2013 through July 31, 2013; and

WHEREAS, both parties now wish to amend the Agreement by extending the term by 13 months, to March 31, 2013, and increasing the maximum amount by \$525,560.36 to an amount not to exceed \$4,442,512.68; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of such Amendment to the Sharing Agreement, has examined and approved it as to both form and content, and desires to enter into it.

### NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the

President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute Amendment No. 2 to the Sharing Agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chief of the Health System or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.
