DAVID FRANKLIN CARBONE

Upon his retirement after 23 years with San Mateo County

WHEREAS, David Franklin Carbone graduated from Cal Poly San Luis Obispo with a degree in City and Regional Planning and joined San Mateo County in 1988 as a Planner III; was promoted to Senior Planner in 1994, was recognized as the San Mateo County Employee of the Month in June 1994, and was promoted to Transportation Systems Coordinator in 2007; and

WHEREAS, David Franklin Carbone began his service at San Mateo County as the San Francisco International Airport/Community Roundtable Coordinator and became the Roundtable Program Manager in 2009 and was instrumental in the many accomplishments of the Roundtable over the past 23 years, including the implementation of various aircraft operational procedures and extensive community and airline outreach, through various educational, media, and training programs, to reduce community noise impacts from aircraft operations at San Francisco International Airport; and

WHEREAS, David Franklin Carbone, administered three federal grants to implement the San Mateo County Aircraft Noise Insulation Program that insulated 45 houses, four churches, and one private school in the unincorporated Country Club Park neighborhood near San Francisco International Airport at no cost to the property owners; and

WHEREAS, David Franklin Carbone, managed the state-mandated airport land use compatibility planning activities of the City/County Association of Governments of San Mateo County (C/CAG) for 21 years; and

WHEREAS, David Franklin Carbone served on the Advisory Board for the FAA Center of Excellence known as PARTNER, the Regional Airport Planning Committee (RAPC) Task Force to update the Regional Airport System Planning Analysis (RASPA) for the nine-county San Francisco Bay Area, three Technical Advisory Committees to assist the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) Division of Aeronautics staff in the preparation of three updates of the *California Airport Land Use Planning Handbook*; and coordinated two national aircraft noise conferences for the National Organization to Insure a Sound-controlled Environment (N.O.I.S.E.) that were held in San Mateo County in 1999 and 2006.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, on February 28, 2012 hereby commends and honors David Franklin Carbone for 23 three years of dedicated public service to the residents of San Mateo County.
