**SUBJECT:** Appropriation Transfer Request

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

Adopt a Resolution approving an Appropriation Transfer Request in the amount of \$55,000 from Network Reserves to the services and supplies budget in the Information Services Department (ISD). This funding will be used to acquire materials and pay for labor to install an additional Internet connection for the County.

### **BACKGROUND:**

The current Countywide Information Technology Strategic Plan (ITSP) recommends increasing our use of cloud-based technologies as well as providing additional services to County residents over the Internet. Both of these recommendations will require additional Internet bandwidth and additional network resiliency. Since Fiscal Year 2000-01 The County has used a Statewide contract with AT&T, currently called Cal-Net II, to reduce the cost of Internet services.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

ISD staff, working with our vendor-partners, has developed a network design providing two distinct paths to the Internet ensuring continued Internet access in the event one of our Internet paths is interrupted. This network design also has a load-balancing effect by distributing our Internet traffic over multiple connections.

With your Board's support, ISD will install an Internet connection at the Health System campus that will work with the County's current Internet connection located on the Redwood City campus. Installing an additional Internet connection on the Health System campus will provide the County with geographic diversity thereby further increasing our fault tolerance. This additional Internet connection will be installed and active in the current Fiscal Year.

By taking advantage of options in the current Cal-Net contract, the County can increase our Internet bandwidth while also reducing the monthly fee we currently pay AT&T for Internet services. This savings is achieved by moving some of the County's smaller network connections spanning County campuses from older technology connections to newer technology connections based on fiber optic technology.

Approval of this ATR contributes to the Shared Vision 2025 outcome of a Collaborative Community because it will provide all County Departments with the increased Internet bandwidth required to support additional Internet-based services.

### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

This will be a multi-year project. This Appropriation Transfer Request for \$55,000 provides funding for materials, ISD labor and vendor services to begin the project in the current Fiscal Year. The total cost for this project is approximately \$125,000, and will be spread over multiple years. Savings of approximately \$1,000/month will be realized when the County moves its circuits to newer, fiber optic based technology. The costs to complete this project will be included in ISD's Recommended budget for Fiscal Year 2012-13.
