SUBJECT: Amendment One to the Agreement with the California Department of

Aging for Title III/VII of the Older American's Act of 1965 for FY 2011-12

RECOMMENDATION:

A) Adopt a Resolution authorizing the President of the Board to execute Amendment One to Agreement AP-1112-08 with the California Department of Aging increasing the total by \$73,338 to \$2,884,507 for the term July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012; and

B) Approve an Appropriation Transfer Request in the amount of \$73,338 from Unanticipated Revenue to Provider Services Programs.

BACKGROUND:

Your Board has designated itself as the Area Agency on Aging (AAA) of San Mateo County to carry out State-funded programs pursuant to the Older Americans Act of 1965. On April 28, 2009, your Board approved the AAA 2009 –12 Area Plan for Services for Older Adults and Adults with Disabilities (Area Plan). This plan, together with the annual budget, fulfills the California Department of Aging's (CDA) requirements and generates a contract from CDA for funding.

On June 21, 2011, your Board authorized Resolution 71470 approving Agreement AP-1112-08 with CDA for funding of the Title III/VII and Nutrition Services Incentive Program (NSIP) programs for FY 2011-12 in the amount of \$2,811,169. This Resolution also authorized the Chief of the Health System or designee to execute limited contract amendments.

Title III/VII and NSIP funding supports a variety of programs including Adult Day Care, Adult Day Health Care, Case Management, Congregate Nutrition, Elder Abuse Prevention, Education and Training, Family Caregiver Support, Health Promotion, Home-Delivered Meals, Information Assistance, Medication Management, Nutrition

Counseling, Nutrition Education, Ombudsman Program, Peer Counseling, Transportation and Senior Employment services. The services provided through these programs have served an average of 13,215 clients annually for the past three years. These services are also designed to carry out many of the goals and objectives identified in the Area Plan and help at-risk individuals remain in the most independent setting possible.

DISCUSSION:

Amendment One increases baseline Title III/VII funding and provides for additional one-time-only federal funding from the past year's grants reconciliation specific to the Ombudsman, Congregate Nutrition, Home-Delivered Meals, Elder Abuse Prevention, Family Caregiver Support and Health Promotion services. It also increases funding for general supportive services funded by Title IIIB and decreases NSIP funding for the Congregate Nutrition and Home-Delivered Meals programs. Amendments to the community-based provider agreements with the corresponding funding changes will be brought to your Board or designee for review and approval.

County Counsel has reviewed and approved the Resolution and Amendment as to form.

The increase in federal funding from this Amendment contributes to the Shared Vision 2025 outcome of a Healthy Community by providing services to at-risk individuals that help them remain in the most independent setting possible. It is anticipated that 95% of at-risk individuals will be maintained in a least restrictive setting through case management.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The term of the Agreement remains July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012. This Agreement is increased by \$75,967 in Title III/VII and one-time-only funds and decreased by \$2,629 in NSIP funds. The maximum obligation for this Agreement is increased by the total net aggregate amount of \$73,338 from \$2,811,169 to \$2,884,507. There is no impact on the Net County Cost as a result of this action.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD TO EXECUTE AMENDMENT ONE TO AGREEMENT AP-1112-08 WITH THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF AGING INCREASING THE TOTAL AMOUNT BY \$73,338 TO \$2,884,507 FOR THE TERM JULY 1, 2011 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2012

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, this Board has designated itself as the Area Agency on Aging of San Mateo County to carry out programs pursuant to the Older Americans Act; and

WHEREAS, on June 21, 2011, this Board approved Resolution 71470 authorizing Agreement AP-1112-08 with the California Department of Aging (CDA) for Title III/VII of the Older American's Act of 1965 funding for FY 2011-12 in the amount of \$2,811,169 for the provision of Adult Day Care, Adult Day Health Care, Case Management, Congregate Nutrition, Elder Abuse Prevention, Family Caregiver Support, Health Promotion, Home-Delivered Meals, Information Assistance, Legal Assistance, Medication Management, Nutrition Counseling, Nutrition Education, Ombudsman Program, Peer Counseling, Transportation Program and Senior Employment services; and

WHEREAS, this Amendment increases baseline funding and adds one-timeonly federal funding from the past year's grants reconciliation specific to the Ombudsman, Congregate Nutrition, Elder Abuse Prevention, Family Caregiver Support, Home-Delivered Meals, Health Promotion and programs supported by Title IIIB in aggregate amount of \$75,967; and

WHEREAS, this Amendment decreases federal Nutrition Services Incentive Program (NSIP) funding for the Congregate Nutrition and Home-Delivered Meals programs in the amount of \$2,629; and

WHEREAS, both parties now wish to amend the Agreement increasing federal one-time-only funding in the amount of \$75,967 and decreasing NSIP funding in the amount of \$2,629 for a net increase to the Agreement of \$73,338 for the purpose of enhancing services or maintaining service levels in the aforementioned programs with no change to the term; and

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Board for its consideration and acceptance an Amendment, reference to which is hereby made for further particulars, and this Board of Supervisors has examined and approved the same as to form and content and desires to enter into the same.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Amendment to Agreement AP-1112-08 with CDA for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.
