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RESOLUTION:

- 1. ADOPTING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, INCLUDING CONFORMANCE WITH PREVAILING WAGE SCALE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE COASTAL TRAIL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT- FITZGERALD MARINE RESERVE - MOSS BEACH AREA; AND**
- 2. AUTHORIZING THE PUBLICATION OF A NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS FOUR TIMES IN A WEEKLY LOCAL NEWSPAPER OF GENERAL CIRCULATION PUBLISHED IN THE COUNTY; AND**
- 3. AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO CALL FOR SEALED PROPOSALS TO BE RECEIVED BY TUESDAY, JULY 3, 2012 AT 2:30 P.M., IN THE OFFICE OF THE CLERK OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, this Board of Supervisors did, on November 9, 2004, adopt Resolution No. 067026, which resolution authorized the filing of an application for local assistance funds from the Per Capita Grant Program of the California Clean Water, Clean Air, Safe Neighborhood Parks and Coastal Protection Act of 2002 (Proposition 40); and

WHEREAS, this Board of Supervisors did, on January 25, 2011, adopt Resolution No. 071246, which approved an application for and acceptance of a \$250,000 grant from the California State Coastal Conservancy for the construction of the Fitzgerald Marine Reserve Coastal Trail, currently referred to as the Coastal Trail Improvement Project – Fitzgerald Marine Reserve; and

WHEREAS, this Board of Supervisors did, on December 13, 2011, adopt

Resolution No. 071758, which authorized \$608,876 of Proposition 40 funding for construction projects within four County parks and \$503,609 of the funding to be used for the Fitzgerald Marine Reserve Coastal Trail and San Vicente Bridge Project (Coastal Trail Improvement Project); and

WHEREAS, plans and specifications, dated June 1, 2012, have been prepared and approved by the Director of Public Works for the Coastal Trail Improvement Project - Fitzgerald Marine Reserve - Moss Beach Area, and said plans and specifications have been filed in the office of the Director of Public Works (the “plans and specifications”); and

WHEREAS, the plans and specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing wages, as established by the Department of Industrial Relations, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of workman needed to execute the contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

1. The plans and specifications, dated June 1, 2012, for the aforesaid project, which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Works, and to which reference is hereby made for further particulars, are hereby approved and adopted as the plans and specifications to be adhered to in letting and performing the work under a contract for the improvements described therein.
2. Said specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing wages, as established by the Department of

Industrial Relations, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of workman needed to execute the contract.

3. The Department of Public Works is authorized and directed to issue a call for sealed proposals and to set the bid opening date and time on or before 2:30 p.m., Tuesday, July 3, 2012, in the office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in the Hall of Justice, Redwood City, California. Said bids will be received by the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and then transmitted to the County Manager's Office in said Hall of Justice and be publicly opened and declared.
4. The Director of Public Works is authorized to extend the call for bids and bid opening up to sixty (60) calendar days beyond the time and date originally set forth by the Board of Supervisors.
5. The Department of Public Works is further directed to cause the Notice inviting sealed bids to be published for four (4) times in a weekly local newspaper of general circulation, published in the County, and to obtain an affidavit of said publication, a copy of which shall be placed on file with the Department of Public Works.

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
