Harris G. Dubrow

For His

Service to The County of San Mateo

WHEREAS, Harris G. Dubrow was born in Chicago, Illinois in 1941 and is a Certified Public Accountant who graduated from San Jose State University in 1963 with a degree in Accounting and Finance and passed the Certified Public Accountant examinations in 1965; and

WHEREAS, Harris began his long and successful accounting career with a San Francisco accountancy firm in 1963 and worked for more than 35 years in that profession of which the majority was spent within the hospitality industry; and

WHEREAS, Harris taught Managerial Accounting and related subjects at the Monterey Institute of Foreign Studies, the Naval Postgraduate School and Skyline College; and

WHEREAS, Harris was first drawn to community service within the county after he answered an ad and attended the San Mateo County Citizen's Academy which provided him with a broad spectrum of the opportunities available to him for county service; and

WHEREAS, Harris' newly discovered opportunities led him to the Civil Grand Jury where he served for terms 2002-2003 and 2003-2004, and was Foreperson Pro Tempore in 2003-2004; and

WHEREAS, after seeing another ad in the local paper, Harris applied to and was named to the San Mateo County Assessment Appeals Board on January 8, 2003, and has chaired the Board since July 2003; and

WHEREAS, Harris' contributions as a San Mateo County resident since 1977 are not limited to his community service on the Assessment Appeals Board and Civil Grand Jury, but have benefitted San Mateo County residents with his volunteer work with Second Harvest, a distributor of food to needy citizens, and Tax Aid, which provides free income tax preparation to low-income individuals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of San Mateo County recognizes and commends Harris G. Dubrow for his years of extraordinary service to The County of San Mateo.
