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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH L.D. STROBEL CO. INC.,
FOR RADIO EQUIPMENT AND INSTALLATION SERVICES FOR THE TERM OF
AUGUST 15, 2012 THROUGH AUGUST 14, 2015, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$633,963**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the County's Information Services Department is currently in the process of implementing a P25 700Mhz Public Safety two-way radio network. The P25 radio system will replace the County's aging legacy radio system in addition to providing public safety first responders an interoperable platform that will allow radio communication with regional allied agencies. As part of this implementation, the County is developing a new communication site for system expansion in La Honda, and relocating an existing facilities site in unincorporated San Mateo; and

WHEREAS, a Request for Proposals, RFP ISD1819, was conducted in January 2012, and L.D. Strobel Co. Inc. was selected to provide radio equipment and installation services; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to enter into an Agreement with L.D. Strobel Co. Inc. for the provision of communication facility and radio tower hardware and installation services from August 15, 2012 through August 14, 2015, in the amount of \$633,963; and

WHEREAS, this Board has considered the Agreement and approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter into it.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Agreement with L.D. Strobel Co. Inc., as is approved by the County Counsel, for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and that the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Information Officer or her/his designee shall be authorized to execute amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate) and/or modify the term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.
