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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH SPECIMEN SPECIALISTS
OF AMERICA INC. FOR THE PROVISION OF FORENSIC PHLEBOTOMY
SERVICES FROM SEPTEMBER 1, 2012 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2015 IN THE
AMOUNT OF \$290,000**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, in the course of law enforcement activities, it is necessary to gather forensic evidence to aid in the prosecution of individuals accused of a crime; and

WHEREAS, in April 2012, a Request for Proposals (RFP) was issued for forensic phlebotomy services; and

WHEREAS, two vendors submitted proposals and Specimen Specialists of America, Inc. was selected based on their timely response, clear procedures associated with chain of custody of evidence and price per draw; and

WHEREAS, the agreement with Specimen Specialists of America, Inc. consist of the collection of blood specimen evidence to be used in the prosecution of driving under the influence and other crimes; and

WHEREAS, this Board finds that it is necessary and desirable that the agreement be executed with Specimen Specialists of America, Inc. agreement, for specified forensic phlebotomy services, for a 34-month term commencing September 1,

2012 through June 30, 2015 in an amount not to exceed \$290,000; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with the agreement with Specimen Specialists of America, Inc. and has examined and approved it as both form and content and desires to enter into the same:

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of the Board be, and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sheriff or Sheriff's designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
