RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Construction Task Catalogs and Specifications require that the

contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing rates of wages,

as established by the Department of Industrial Relations, in the locality in which said

work is to be performed for each type of worker needed to execute the contract.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as

follows:

 The Construction Task Catalogs and Specifications dated October 2012 for the County of San Mateo Job Order Contracts for General Construction, which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Works, and to which reference is hereby made for further particulars, are hereby approved and adopted as the catalog and specifications to be adhered to in letting and performing the work under contracts for said improvements.

- 2) Said specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing rate of wages, as established by the Department of Industrial Relations, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of worker needed to execute the contract.
- 3) The Department of Public Works is further directed to cause the Notice inviting sealed bids to be published two (2) times in a weekly local newspaper of general circulation, published in the County, and to obtain an affidavit of said publication, a copy of which shall be placed on file with the Department of Public Works.

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
