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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH BIGGS CARDOSA ASSOCIATES, INC. FOR ENGINEERING AND ENVIRONMENTAL PERMITTING SERVICES FOR THE TERM OF NOVEMBER 20, 2012 THROUGH NOVEMBER 19, 2015 IN AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED \$145,000

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo is authorized to engage the services of professional technical experts; and

WHEREAS, the public interest and general welfare will be served by selecting and utilizing Biggs Cardosa Associates, Inc. for Engineering and Environmental Permitting Services for the Preventative Maintenance for Various County Bridges in the Unincorporated Areas of San Mateo County Project; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works and Parks is interested in executing a professional services agreement with Biggs Cardosa Associates, Inc. for a three-year period; and

WHEREAS, Biggs Cardosa Associates, Inc. is qualified to perform engineering and environmental permitting services for the Preventative Maintenance for Various County Bridges; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works and Parks has recommended that an

agreement be entered into with Biggs Cardosa Associates, Inc. to perform Engineering and Environmental Permitting Services for the Preventative Maintenance for Various County Bridges; and

WHEREAS, this Board has considered the recommendation of the Director of Public Works and Parks.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that:

1. The President of this Board of Supervisors shall be, and is hereby, authorized and directed to execute an Agreement with Biggs Cardosa Associates, Inc. to provide Engineering and Environmental Permitting Services for the Preventative Maintenance for Various County Bridges in an amount not to exceed \$145,000, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto; and
2. Authorize the Director of the Department of Public Works and Parks or designee to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
