WHEREAS, the San Mateo County Narcotics Task Force actively participates

in local, state and federal narcotic related investigations in the County; and

WHEREAS, the San Mateo County Sheriff's Office desires to participate in the

Anti-Drug Abuse Enforcement Team Grant Program supported by the Edward Byrne

Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program funds and administered by the Board of

State and Community Corrections; and

WHEREAS, the Anti-Drug Abuse Justice Assistance Grant Program supports

multi-jurisdictional drug task forces in each of California's 58 counties to combat manufacturing, distribution and drug sales; and

WHEREAS, the Board of State and Community Corrections has allocated \$205,208 from the Anti-Drug Abuse Enforcement Team Program to the County of San Mateo; and

WHEREAS, funding will be utilized to supplement overtime costs for 24 sworn personnel and pay the costs of the project audit:
