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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A NO PARKING ZONE
AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF ASHTON AVENUE AND ALAMEDA DE LAS
PULGAS IN WEST MENLO PARK AND ON THE EASTERLY SIDE OF THE
ALAMEDA NEAR SANTIAGO AVENUE IN EL GRANADA**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 22507 et. al. and Section 7.30.010 of the County Ordinance Code allow the Board of Supervisors to establish no parking zones and associated signs and markings; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works and Parks has recommended that a no parking zone be established as noted herein; and

WHEREAS, this Board has reviewed and concurs with the recommendation of the Director of Public Works and Parks.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that:

1. A no parking zone be established at the following locations:

- Ashton Avenue (County Road No. 537), West Menlo Park Area.

On the south side of ASHTON AVENUE commencing at approximately 50 feet west of the center line of Alameda De Las Pulgas and extending west

a distance of 19 feet, more or less.

- The Alameda (County Road No.919), El Granada Area

On the easterly side of THE ALAMEDA commencing at approximately 69 feet north of center line of Santiago Avenue and extending northerly a distance of 19 feet, more or less.

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
