**WHEREAS,** according to the United States Department of Agriculture, 14.9% of American households were food insecure at least some time during the year, including 5.7% with very low food security; and

WHEREAS, CalFresh is a program that can add to your food budget to put healthy and nutritious food on the table for qualified households and individuals; and

**WHEREAS**, despite yearly increases of families and individuals enrolled in **CalFresh** benefits, there are still many residents in immediate need of food assistance who are unaware that they may be eligible for **CalFresh**; and

**WHEREAS**, **CalFresh Awareness Month** will feature public awareness activities aimed at increasing access and participation in food assistance and reducing food insecurity in San Mateo County.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, does hereby proclaim the month of May 2013 in San Mateo County as **CalFresh Awareness Month** and urges all community agencies, faith-based organizations, medical clinics and community partners to promote **CalFresh** awareness and increase the **CalFresh** participation rate in our county."
