RECOMMENDATION:

Recommendation for the re-appointment of Robert Guzzetta to the Bay Area Water Supply and Conservation Agency for a four-year term, beginning July 1, 2013.

BACKGROUND:

The Bay Area Water Supply and Conservation Agency (BAWSCA) was created on May 27, 2003 to represent the interests of 24 cities and water districts, and two private utilities, in Alameda, Santa Clara and San Mateo counties that purchase water on a wholesale basis from the San Francisco regional water system.

Mr. Robert Guzzetta is Cal Water's Vice President, Operations and has served as a Bay Area Water Supply and Conservation Agency (BAWSCA) Director since July 1, 2005. Mr. Robert Guzzetta wishes to be re-appointed to serve another four-year term, beginning July 1, 2013.

DISCUSSION:

This appointment contributes to the 2025 Shared Vision statement of a Collaborative Community. Our diverse population works well together to build strong communities, effective government and a prosperous economy, civic engagement – including voting, public service, charitable giving, volunteerism, and participation in public discussions of important issues – is uniformly high among the diverse population of San Mateo County.
