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RESOLUTION:

- A) ADOPTING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, INCLUDING CONFORMANCE WITH PREVAILING WAGE SCALE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ALPINE ROAD AT I-280 RESURFACING AND BICYCLE IMPROVEMENTS; AND**
B) THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS AND PARKS TO CALL FOR SEALED PROPOSALS TO BE RECEIVED BY JUNE 11, 2013 AT 2:30 P.M., IN THE OFFICE OF THE CLERK OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, this Board of Supervisors did, on September 11, 2012, adopt Resolution No. 072172, which authorized the Director of Public Works and Parks or his designee to submit an application with the City/County Association of Governments (C/CAG) of San Mateo County and the San Mateo County Transportation Authority (SMCTA) to receive funds from the State Local Partnership Program (SLPP) to resurface various streets in the unincorporated areas of San Mateo County.

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo applied for SLPP funds for projects that will extend the pavement life by approximately 15 years, which were allocated by the California Transportation Commission at its May 7, 2013 meeting; and

WHEREAS, the plans and specifications, dated March 6, 2013, have been prepared and approved by the Director of Public Works and Parks for the Alpine Road at I-280 Resurfacing and Bicycle Improvements 2013 Project, and said plans and

specifications have been filed in the office of the Director of Public Works and Parks (the “plans and specifications”); and

WHEREAS, the plans and specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing wages, as established by the Department of Industrial Relations, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of workman needed to execute the contract.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

1. The plans and specifications, dated March 6, 2013, for the aforesaid project, which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Works and Parks, and to which reference is hereby made for further particulars, are hereby approved and adopted as the plans and specifications to be adhered to in letting and performing the work under a contract for the improvements described therein.
2. Said specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing wages, as established by the Department of Industrial Relations, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of workman needed to execute the contract.
3. The Department of Public Works and Parks is authorized and directed to issue a call for sealed proposals and to set the bid opening date and time on or before 2:30 p.m., June 11, 2013 in the office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in the Hall of Justice, Redwood City, California. Said bids will be received by the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and then transmitted to the County Manager’s

Office in said Hall of Justice and be publicly opened and declared.

4. The Director of Public Works and Parks is authorized to extend the call for bids and bid opening up to sixty (60) calendar days beyond the time and date originally set forth by the Board of Supervisors.
5. The Department of Public Works is further directed to cause the Notice inviting sealed bids to be published for two (2) times in a weekly local newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in this County, and to obtain an affidavit of said publication, a copy of which shall be placed on file with the Department of Public Works and Parks.

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
