BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING:

A) AN AGREEMENT WITH BLOCKA CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR THE LOOP ROAD SECURITY PROJECT AT THE YOUTH SERVICES CENTER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,022,000; AND

B) THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO EXECUTE SUBSEQUENT CHANGE ORDERS TO GRANT TIME EXTENSIONS FOR PROJECT COMPLETION AND PAYMENT UP TO A MAXIMUM AGGREGATE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$102,200 OR APPROXIMATELY 10% OF THE AGREEMENT AMOUNT

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, this Board of Supervisors did, on April 23, 2013, adopt Resolution No. 072476, which adopted the plans and specifications ("Plans and Specifications"), including conformance with prevailing wage scale requirements and calling for sealed bids for the Loop Road Security Project at the Youth Services Center; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk of this Board of Supervisors did, in public on May 23, 2013 open and examine all sealed bids that were received in the specified time for the doing of the work referred to in said Resolution No. 072476; and

WHEREAS, this Board of Supervisors has caused an analysis of said bids to be made by the Director of Public Works of the County of San Mateo, and has, in open session, fully reviewed and considered said bids and the analysis thereof; and

WHEREAS, although one lower bid was submitted, the bidder requested subsequently to have their bid withdrawn because of a clerical error, and therefore the Department of Public Works has relieved the bidder from having their bid considered; and

WHEREAS, the second lowest responsible bid was submitted by Blocka Construction, Inc., in the amount of \$1,022,000 based on the estimate of the amount of the work to be done.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

1. It is in the best interest of the County of San Mateo to allow the withdrawal of the initial lowest bidder at the time of bid opening and award the agreement for the Loop Road Security Project at the Youth Services Center to:

2. The County of San Mateo shall enter into a written agreement with Blocka Construction, Inc. for the completion of said work as required by the Plans and Specifications adopted by this Board of Supervisors, as hereinbefore mentioned, which Plans and Specifications are on file in the office of the Director of Public Works of the County of San Mateo.
3. The President of this Board of Supervisors shall be, and is hereby, authorized and directed to execute an agreement with Blocka Construction, Inc. for the doing of said work described herein, subject to the Department of Public Works'

receipt and approval of the Faithful Performance Surety Bond ("Performance Bond") and the Labor and Material Surety Bond ("Payment Bond") required to be posted by the said Contractor with the County of San Mateo in connection therewith.

4. All payments to the Contractor shall be in accordance with the Plans and Specifications, and other agreement documents. Aggregate payment to the Contractor shall not exceed \$1,022,000.
5. The Director of Public Works is authorized to execute subsequent change orders up to a maximum aggregate amount, not to exceed \$102,200, or 10% of the Agreement amount.
6. The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, County of San Mateo, is hereby authorized and directed to attest the signature of the President of this Board of Supervisors to said written agreement.

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
