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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH SCRIPTPRO USA, INC. TO PROVIDE A ROBOTIC PRESCRIPTION DISPENSING SYSTEM AT SAN MATEO MEDICAL CENTER, EXTENDING THE TERM THROUGH JUNE 30, 2014, INCREASING THE AMOUNT BY \$40,000 TO AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$250,200

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, ScriptPro USA, Inc. (ScriptPro) provides a Robotic Prescription

Dispensing System (RPDS) that automates repetitive manual dispensing tasks

accurately and efficiently; and

WHEREAS, the RPDS interfaces with San Mateo Medical Center's (SMMC)

Pharmacy Computer System to fill, label, and deliver up to 150 prescriptions per hour;

dispensing tablets and capsules of all shapes and sizes into standard pharmacy vials;

and

WHEREAS, a RPDS plays a vital role in the continuity and success of SMMC's efforts to reduce waiting times and increasing the accuracy and efficiency of filling the prescriptions of SMMC's patients; and

WHEREAS, SMMC is extending the term of the current agreement by eight months to allow time for the Director of Pharmacy to evaluate new RPDS technology that has become available since this agreement was approved; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Pharmacy is currently researching and gathering information for comprehensive Request for Proposals (RFP) for a new RPDS that will be issued in August 2013; and

WHEREAS, both parties now wish to amend the agreement extending the term of the agreement through June 30, 2014, and increase the amount by \$40,000 for a maximum fiscal obligation of \$250,200

WHEREAS, the Board has been presented a form of the amendment and has examined and approved as to both form and content and desires to enter into it.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said amendment for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

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
