Motel Voucher. Transitional Housing for Families With Special Needs. Inclement Weather Programs and Emergency Funding for Hallmark Fire Victims 2013-14

In consideration of the payments set forth in Exhibits "B1", Contractor will provide the following services under the general direction of the Director of the Human Services Agency (HSA) or his/her authorized representatives:

- 1. Recruitment of motels to house fire victims:
- 2. Negotiate the rate of payments for vouchers with participating motels;
- 3. Provide vouchers to fire victims/clients and/or issue vouchers to participating motels per HSA's directions;
- 4. Work with clients closely to ensure that temporary housing needs are met:
- 5. Work with other agencies such as County's Behavioral Health and Recovery Services, Department of Housing, Mental Health Association of San Mateo County, Red Cross, and HSA's Economic Self Sufficiency and connect the clients to appropriate and eligible services:
- 6. Coordinate plans for the families receiving benefits through communication with HSA's case worker/benefit analyst.
- 7. Receive invoices and pay motels using the established vouchers;
- 8. Facilitate the clients' entry to one of InnVision Shelter Network's shelters for appropriate families and individuals:
- 9. Participate in multi-disciplinary meetings conducted by HSA or other local Core Services Agencies; and
- 10. Provide weekly follow-up reports to the Human Services Agency Center on Homelessness. Reports should include information on the client's housing conditions.

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Exhibit B1 Method and Rate of Payment InnVision Shelter Network

Motel Voucher, Transitional Housing for Families With Special Needs, inclement Weather Programs and Emergency Funding for Hallmark Fire Victims 2013-14

In full consideration of the services provided by the Contractor pursuant to this Amendment and as listed in Exhibit A2, the County shall pay the Contractor:

- A. Total amount of \$273,000 for direct motel expenses. Monthly invoices are to be submitted to the San Mateo County Human Services Agency Center on Homelessness, Ali Shirkhani 472 Harbor Boulevard, Building C Belmont, CA 94002. Phone (650) 802-7675. Invoices submitted for fire victim's motel expenses must be sent separately from the regular Motel Voucher Program invoices.
- B. Total amount of \$24,000 for case manager services on a monthly basis.

In any event the total payment for the services listed in Exhibit A2 for the FY 2013-14 shall not to exceed \$297,000. All invoices should include appropriate back up/reports such as: motel bills for rooms, clients list/names, and number of nights in motel.
