AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3.52.200 OF CHAPTER 3.52 (FIREARMS) OF TITLE 3 (PUBLIC SAFETY, MORALS AND WELFARE) OF THE SAN MATEO COUNTY ORIDNANCE CODE, RELATING TO THE POSSESSION AND SALE OF FIREARMS BY COUNTY OFFICIALS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, ORDAINS as follows

SECTION 1. Section 3.52.200(C) of Chapter 3.52 of Title 3 of the San Mateo County Ordinance Code is amended and restated in its entirety to read as follows:

(C) Notwithstanding subdivision (B) above, the County may sell any firearm owned or possessed by the County, and determined by the Sheriff to be surplus property, to: (i) the following sworn personnel employed by the Sheriff's Office:

Deputies, Sergeants, Lieutenants, and Captains, and the Assistant Sheriff, Undersheriff, and Sheriff; (ii) firearm manufacturers; or (iii) another law enforcement agency, provided that any such sale is otherwise permissible under applicable state and federal law.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be effective 30 days from the date of passage thereof.
