RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE FY 2013 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM AWARD, FOR THE TERM OF OCTOBER 1, 2012 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2016, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$106,221

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grants (JAG) Program, through the of U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, supports all components of the criminal justice system and addresses crime through the provision of services directly to individuals and/or communities and by improving the effectiveness and efficiency of criminal justice systems, processes and procedures; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office, on behalf of the County of San Mateo and disparate jurisdictions, which include Daly City, East Palo Alto, Redwood City, San Mateo, and South San Francisco, applied for and was awarded the FY 2013 Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grants Program, in the amount of \$106,221; and

WHEREAS, the County and cities agreed that the Sheriff's Office will be the fiscal agent and that 10% of each jurisdiction's allocated amount be designated as an administrative fee which will be used to fund training to provide Sheriff's staff with the skills and analytical tools to ensure proper management of grants, contracts and requests for proposals; and

WHEREAS, in a collaborative effort to help alleviate the effects of ongoing budget reductions, the Sheriff's Office, in agreement with the Chiefs of Police from the disparate cities, will expend FY 2013 JAG funds for the analyses of all types of evidence submitted to the Sheriff's Office Forensic Laboratory; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors, on behalf of the County of San Mateo, hereby accepts the FY 2013 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program in the amount of \$106,221.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sheriff or Sheriff's designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute all necessary documents in connection with this grant, including but not limited to, agreements, amendments, and grant assurances.
