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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH JOBTRAIN TO DELIVER WORKFORCE INVESTMENT ACT COMPREHENSIVE YEAR ROUND YOUTH EMPLOYMENT SERVICES FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2014 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2015, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$400,000

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the San Mateo County Workforce Investment Board (SMCWIB), as directed in the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) federal regulations, 20 CFR 661.305 (a) (3), manages oversight and related activities of local WIA Youth programs and services; and

WHEREAS, a Request for Proposal was launched in January, 2014, and the SMCWIB Youth RFP Review Committee recommends approval to execute contract agreements with three youth service providers to deliver employment, skill building and education programs to WIA eligible youth; and

WHEREAS, JobTrain, one of the three youth service providers, will deliver youth programs and services to 115 WIA youth participants with targeted outcomes of Entered Employment and Education, Attainment of a Degree or Certificate or Literacy and Numeracy gains; and

WHEREAS, the Workforce and Economic Development Division requests your

Board to authorize the Director of Workforce and Economic Development as a designee for the County Manager's office to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the

President of the Board is here by authorized and directed to execute said agreement with JobTrain to deliver programs and services to WIA youth for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

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
