CONTRACTS BY \$267,500 ONE-TIME FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014-15 AS PART OF

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, it is critical for the County to provide basic emergency and support services, which include food, transportation, shelter referrals, housing assistance and client advocacy, known as "core services" for the residents of San Mateo County; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented for its consideration and acceptance a one-time allocation of \$267,500 to the eight Core Service Agencies, also known as "the Cores", that provide these basic emergency and support services to residents of the County, in order to continue and maintain these vital services at an appropriate level, and a plan outlining steps toward creating a sustainable Core Service Agency network; and

WHEREAS, it is requested that the Board of Supervisors direct the County

Manager or his designee to increase the agreements with the Core Service Agencies

for a one-time total amount of \$267,500 as part of the Safety Net Sustainability Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the County Manager or his designee is authorized to increase the agreements with the Core Service Agencies for a one-time total amount of \$267,500 as part of the Safety Net Sustainability Plan.

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
