RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO VOTE IN FAVOR OF THE FORMATION OF THE DOWNTOWN REDWOOD CITY COMMUNITY BENEFIT IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, The City of Redwood City has worked with property owners in the downtown area for the past year on the creation of a Downtown Redwood City Community Benefit Improvement District (District) that would provide enhanced services to properties in the downtown area, including steam cleaning of sidewalks, enhanced trash collection, additional landscaping, promotion programs and valet and other parking services; and

WHEREAS the creation of the District requires a vote by the property owners in the proposed District; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo owns eleven percent of the property in the proposed District; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that creation of the proposed District would benefit the County and the property owned by the County within the District; and

WHEREAS, on June 11, 2014, the Board of Supervisors directed the County

Manager to sign a petition in support of the creation of the District; and

WHEREAS, the petition for formation of the District has received sufficient support and, pursuant to State law, the creation of the District is now being brought to the property owners for a vote; and

WHEREAS, the County has received a ballot regarding whether he County favors the formation of the District; and

WHEREAS, the materials received with this ballot indicate that the initial District assessment on the County would be \$77,618.75 in 2015.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the

County Manager is authorized and directed to vote in favor of the formation of the

Downtown Redwood City Community Benefit Improvement District, for and on behalf of
the County of San Mateo.
