

**RESOLUTION NO. 073304**

**BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA  
ACTING AS THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE TEN COUNTY SEWER  
MAINTENANCE AND SANITATION DISTRICTS**

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**RESOLUTION:**

- A) RE-CERTIFYING THE SEWER SYSTEM MANAGEMENT PLAN IN  
ACCORDANCE WITH THE CALIFORNIA STATE WATER RESOURCES  
CONTROL BOARD STATEWIDE GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE  
REQUIREMENTS FOR SANITARY SEWER SYSTEMS; AND  
B) DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO IMPLEMENT AND  
PERIODICALLY UPDATE THE REVISED SEWER SYSTEM MANAGEMENT PLAN  
AS NECESSARY TO COMPLY WITH CURRENT REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS  
AND BEST PRACTICES**

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**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, as the Governing Board of the following County Sewer Maintenance and Sanitation Districts (Districts):

**Burlingame Hills Sewer Maintenance District;  
Crystal Springs County Sanitation District;  
Devonshire County Sanitation District;  
Edgewood Sewer Maintenance District;  
Emerald Lake Heights Sewer Maintenance District;  
Fair Oaks Sewer Maintenance District;  
Harbor Industrial Sewer Maintenance District;  
Kensington Square Sewer Maintenance District;  
Oak Knoll Sewer Maintenance District; and  
Scenic Heights County Sanitation District.**

**WHEREAS**, the Districts own, operate, and maintain approximately 150 miles of sanitary sewer pipelines; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the Districts' responsibility to effectively manage the sewer systems to minimize sanitary sewer overflows (SSOs); and

**WHEREAS**, the State of California Water Resources Control Board has adopted

Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Sanitary Sewer Systems Order No. 2006-0003 (Order) to provide a consistent, statewide regulatory approach to address SSOs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Order requires the preparation and approval of a Sewer System Management Plan (SSMP) by all public agencies that own or operate sanitary sewer systems greater than one mile in length that collect and/or convey wastewater to a publicly owned treatment facility; and

**WHEREAS**, the Order also requires these public agencies to update their SSMPs every five years to include significant program changes and re-certify the SSMP by their governing board at a public meeting when significant updates to the SSMP are made; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 070339, on August 25, 2009 approving the SSMP prepared in accordance with the Order and directing the Director of Public Works to implement and periodically update the SSMP as necessary to comply with current regulatory requirements and best practices; and

**WHEREAS**, the SSMP has been updated by staff in compliance with the requirements set forth by the Order; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has been provided the opportunity to review the updated SSMP.

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that:

1. Acting as the governing board of the Districts, this Board does hereby find,

determine and declare that the Sewer System Management Plan updated by staff in accordance with the California State Water Resources Control Board Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Sanitary Sewer Systems and dated July 15, 2014 is approved and re-certified.

2. The Director of Public Works is hereby directed to implement and periodically update the approved Sewer System Management Plan as necessary to comply with current regulatory requirements and best practices.

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
