Subject: Green Street Improvement Project on Carlos Street Between Etheldore Street and California Avenue in the Moss Beach Area
[County Project No. OM021; Project File No. 1/4924]

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt a Resolution authorizing:

- A) The President of the Board to execute an agreement with Interstate Grading & Paving, Inc., for the Green Street Improvement Project on Carlos Street between Etheldore Street and California Avenue in the Moss Beach area, in the amount of \$207,775; and
- B) The Director of Public Works to execute subsequent change orders to grant time extensions for project completion and payment up to a maximum aggregate amount not to exceed \$20,800, or approximately 10% of the agreement amount.

BACKGROUND:

On May 24, 2011, your Board adopted Resolution No. 071429, authorizing execution of Grant Agreement No. 10-402-550 with the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) in the amount of \$2.3 million for the James V. Fitzgerald ASBS Pollution Reduction Program (Fitzgerald Program). The Fitzgerald Program is funded by the California Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control, River and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2006 (Proposition 84).

On September 10, 2013, your Board adopted Resolution No. 072798, which adopted a Labor Compliance Program and authorized the Director of Public Works to implement the adopted Labor Compliance Program as required by the provisions of Proposition 84.

On May 28, 2014, the San Mateo County Planning Commission (Commission) approved a Coastal Development Permit for construction of the Green Street Improvement Project on Carlos Street between Etheldore Street and California Avenue

(Project). The Commission also found that the Project is categorically exempt pursuant to Section 15301 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), and a Notice of Exemption for a CEQA Categorical Exemption has been filed.

On June 17, 2014, your Board adopted Resolution No. 073247, which adopted plans and specifications, including conformance with prevailing wage scale requirements and Labor Compliance Program requirements and called for sealed bids for the above mentioned project.

DISCUSSION:

On Thursday, July 10, 2014, bids were accepted for this project and subsequently referred to Public Works for checking and recommendation. The bid of:

Interstate Grading & Paving, Inc.
128 S. Maple Avenue
South San Francisco, CA 94080

at \$207,775 was the lowest responsible bid received for the work. The Engineer's Estimate was \$227,150. A summary of the bids received is attached as Exhibit "A".

Staff reviewed the bid documents and determined that the Equal Employment program submitted by Interstate Grading & Paving, Inc., is in accordance with the current Equal Employment Guidelines and that the Contractor complies with the equal benefits and jury duty pay provisions of the County ordinance code.

County Counsel has reviewed and approved the Resolution and Agreement as to form.

Approval of this action will contribute to the Shared Vision 2025 outcome of an Environmentally Conscious Community by enabling the Department to continue implementation of the Fitzgerald Program to promote environmental stewardship and protect beneficial uses and biological resources of the Fitzgerald ASBS.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The total estimated cost for construction is \$228,575, which includes authorization for up to \$20,800 in change orders as the work is bid on a unit price basis. The contingency is used to pay the contractor for any unforeseen conditions not anticipated in the construction agreement documents.

The project is proposed to be financed as follows:

Road Funds	<u>\$103,575</u>
Total Estimated Cost	\$228,575

There is no impact to the General Fund.
