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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH
ADDICTION RESEARCH AND TREATMENT, INC. FOR NARCOTIC REPLACEMENT
THERAPY SERVICES, INCREASING THE AMOUNT BY \$1,204,151 TO AN AMOUNT
NOT TO EXCEED \$2,477,479**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, on June 18, 2013, your Board approved an agreement with Addiction Research and Treatment, Inc. to provide narcotic replacement therapy services, for a maximum obligation of \$622,654; and

WHEREAS, on April 22, 2014, your Board approved a first amendment to the agreement, extending the term of the agreement through June 30, 2015, and increasing the maximum obligation by \$622,654 to \$1,245,308; and

WHEREAS, on May 30, 2014, the Chief of the Health System approved a second amendment to the agreement adding a cost of living adjustment, increasing the maximum amount by \$28,020 to \$1,273,328.

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Board of Supervisors for its consideration and acceptance a third amendment to the agreement, reference to which is hereby made for further particulars, whereby Addiction Research and Treatment, Inc. shall provide additional narcotic replacement therapy services; and

WHEREAS, the maximum obligation is being increased by \$1,204,151 to a new

maximum obligation of \$2,477,479 with no change to the agreement term of July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2015; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a third amendment to the agreement and has examined and approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter into this amended agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said third amendment to the agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

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
