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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH WEST
ED TO DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT AN EVALUATION PLAN TO MEASURE THE
SUCCESS OF THE ALLIANCE FOR LANGUAGE LEARNERS' INTEGRATION,
EDUCATION, AND SUCCESS GRANT ACTIVITIES AND PILOT PROGRAMS,
INCREASING THE AMOUNT BY \$30,000 TO \$395,000**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, in July, 2012, San Mateo County was awarded funds in the amount of \$2.6M to implement the Alliance for Language Learners' Integration, Education, and Success (ALLIES) federal grant program; and

WHEREAS, the San Mateo County Workforce and Economic Development division (SMCWED) provides administrative oversight of the ALLIES grant and coordinates with education, workforce and community based partners to support and implement pilot programs that provide English language instruction for immigrant workers; and

WHEREAS, West Ed is the evaluator for the ALLIES program that will evaluate and measure the success of ALLIES grant activities and pilot programs such as incumbent worker training classes for those who need to improve English language and job readiness skills; and

WHEREAS, the amendment will increase the amount by \$30,000 for a new

fiscal obligation of \$395,000 and will enable West Ed to evaluate up to three additional ALLIES incumbent worker training cohort classes for the purpose of serving more ALLIES participants and achieving up to three more successful incumbent worker training classes.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of the Board authorizes and signs said amendment on behalf of San Mateo County and the Clerk of the Board to serve more ALLIES participants and deliver three more successful training cohort classes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Director of Workforce and Economic Development or his or her designee is hereby authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
