RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF PROBATION OFFICER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT ONE-TIME STATE FUNDING IN FY 2014-15 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$250,000 THROUGH THE COMMUNITY RECIDIVISM REDUCTION GRANT FUNDING ADMINISTERED BY THE BOARD OF STATE AND COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS

**RESOLVED,** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Probation Department desires to receive and utilize State grant funds through Community Recidivism Reduction Grant Funding administered by the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) through the State Budget Act of 2014; and

WHEREAS, BSCC has made available funds of up to \$250,000 to San Mateo County through the Community Recidivism Reduction Grant to develop and administer a competitive grant program intended to fund community recidivism and crime reduction services to persons who have been released from State prison, a county jail, or a juvenile detention facility, who are under the supervision of a parole or probation department; and

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 109 or the Public Safety Realignment Act of 2011, shifted the responsibility of incarcerating and supervising many low-risk offenders from the State to counties; and

WHEREAS, in April 2011, San Mateo County established it's Community Corrections Partnership (CCP) to work collaboratively with all of its stakeholders in the oversight of programs and services geared towards the AB109 population through the adoption of the Local Implementation Plan (LIP) that consists of twelve (12) strategies for supervising and serving the newly realigned populations; and

WHEREAS, in 2012, the CCP developed and administered a competitive Request for Proposals (RFP) process for community-based organizations that provide services and programs directed towards reducing the recidivism rate of both the Post Release Community Supervision (PRCS) and 1170(h) populations; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board has approved the Resolution and has examined and approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter into it.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Chief Probation Officer or his designee is hereby authorized to accept one-time State funds available for FY 2014-15 in the amount of \$250,000 through the Community Recidivism Reduction Grant Funding administered by the Board of State and Community Corrections
